Darren Griffin is Professor of Genetics at the University of Kent.

He is director of the Centre for Interdisciplinary Studies of Reproduction, which has a remit to encourage cross-disciplinary endeavour.

He is president of the International Chromosome and Genome Society that administered the International Chromosome Conferences.

His personal research interests include the study of chromosome analysis, the genetics of early human development (including preimplantation genetic diagnosis), chromosome evolution and computer based learning in genetics.

He has published over 150 scholarly manuscripts and raised over £6 million in grant funding.

He is a regular contributor to the national and local media, speaking on issues such as “designer babies” and personalized genomics.
