Maurizio received an MSc in Medical Biotechnology from the University of Bologna. He worked as a clinical embryologist in Dublin and Oxford. His primary research interest is the development of novel strategies for the assessment of human embryos competence.

Maurizio is a co-founder of Reproomics, a company developing proteomic technologies to improve the outcome of IVF treatments. Maurizio is an ACE certified embryologist and an HCPC registered Clinical Scientist. He is an ESHRE certified Senior Clinical Embryologist and an Associate of the Royal College of Pathologists in the UK. Maurizio also works as a locum embryologist and scientific advisor for IVF clinics in Europe.
